

Policy for Safe Worship during Covid-19

- Masks are required for those able to wear one. Masks will be available at the Church
- All elderly and at-risk individuals are encouraged to use caution and discretion when attending worship
- If you are sick or think you may have been exposed to COVID-19, please stay home
- If you are not ready to join folks in worship, please stay home. We understand and want you to be safe and healthy. Our Worship service will continue to be provided via Facebook Live for those who are unable to join us.

Arrival for Worship Service

- When you arrive, you will be greeted from a safe distance. Bulletins will be on table for you, No contact will be made
- Seating will maintain physical distance between families. Please do not expect to sit in your usual place; we will be directing you to sit at alternate ends of pews to put at least one empty pew in front and behind of each family or individual.
- There will NOT be a Children's sermon where children gather together at the front
- There will NOT be Sunday School for children at this time
- We will NOT be practicing communion at this time
- We will NOT be passing an offering plate, An Offering Basket will be provided at the door for you to drop your contribution in on the way out.
- We will NOT include congregational singing. We encourage you to enjoy the live music or videos presented and feel free to hum along 😊
- Attendance will be taken, so that we can notify you in case we come to find out a worshiper was present with Covid-19.

To maintain cleanliness, we will

- Clean and disinfect the restrooms before and after worship
- Disinfect and wipe down all surfaces that may be touched.
- Provide hand sanitizer
